What does the G.E.D. measure?

The GED Test is designed to measure the skills and concepts which are usually learned during four years of regular high school.

Who may take the GED test in California?

Any individual within 60 days of his/her 18th birthday. Tests may not be administered to candidates who are enrolled in an accredited high school.

Any individual within 60 days of when he/she would have graduated from high school had he/she remained in school.

Any individual who is 17 years of age, has been out of school for at least 60 consecutive days, and provides a letter of request for the test from the military, a post-secondary institution, or a prospective employer.

What do you do next?

- Register at myGED.com
- Attend a GED study session and take the pre-test, the test will measure what areas you can study to better prepare for the test.
- You may use the GED study hours to prepare for the GED test. A teacher is always present to help.
- When you are ready to test go on line to the GED test site, myGED.com, and register to take the test at any of the approved test center locations including Ramona, payment for the test will be required on line when you register to take the test. Currently each test is \$35.00 and there is a series of 4 tests that must be passed; English, Social Science, Math and Science. When your appointment is made, take the test and be ready to open all the doors to your future!
